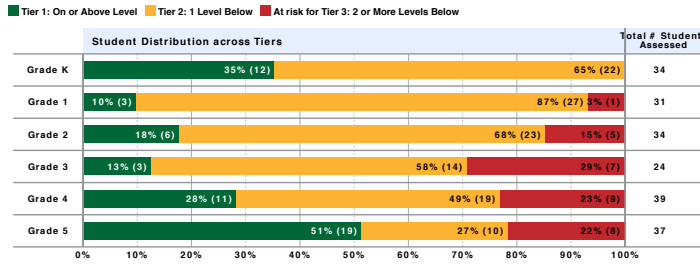
Ali'iolani's i-Ready Growth

Our students have been working very hard this year and the data proves it.

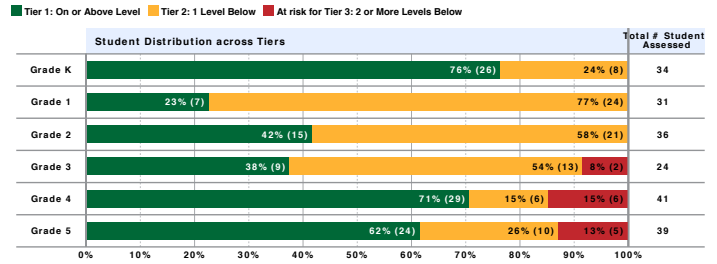

Our dedicated staff has adopted i-Ready and is using it as a tool to help support classroom learning. Our children are well on their way! Keep up the great work Ali'i!

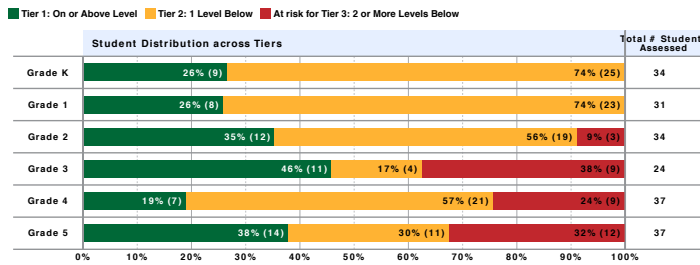
Detail by Grade **Math - Fall (Aug-Sep)**



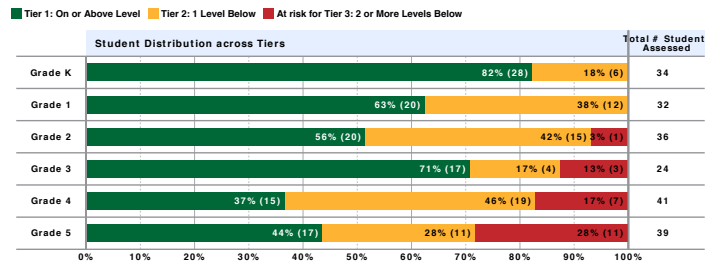
Detail by Grade **Math - Winter (Nov-Dec)**
