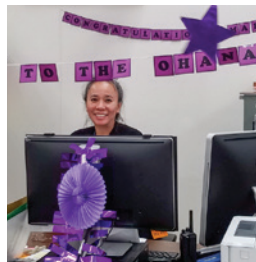
A Message from our Principal
